Winter Shutdown and Construction Progress Notice Queen Street West (south side)

Downtown Brampton Streetscape Project
Shutdown Start Date: February 25, 2026 Shutdown End Date: Mid April 2026

As part of the Downtown Brampton Streetscaping Project, the City of Brampton has been widening sidewalks, implementing bike paths and renewing old drainage and stormwater infrastructure along Queen Street from Chapel Street to Mill Street South in the heart of downtown Brampton.

We're pleased to announce that Phase 3B of the project, Queen Street West (south side) from Elizabeth Street South to George Street South is complete. The project will pause for a winter shutdown when weather conditions are not suitable for construction activities, starting from February 25, 2026, and returning to work mid April 2026.

This work aims to make Downtown Brampton a more vibrant and pedestrian-friendly environment with people, promoting a prosperous and thriving community with people at the centre of its design.

Schedule for Remaining Construction

- Phase 3C, from Elizabeth Street South to Mill Street South along Queen Street West on south side, will begin construction in Spring 2026.
- More details about upcoming construction activities will be shared in a future notice.
