INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To Balbir Sohi, Candidate and the Clerk of the City of Brampton

Report on the Audit of the Financial Statement - Auditor's Report Candidate - Form 4

Qualified Opinion

I have audited the accompanying financial statement - auditor's report Form 4 of Balbir Sohi ("the Candidate"), which comprises the statement of campaign income and expenses from May 1, 2018 to April 16, 2019 and the calculation of deficit as at April 16, 2019, and related explanatory schedules. The financial statement has been prepared by the Candidate using the financial reporting provisions under section 88 of the Ontario Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

In my opinion, except for the effects of the matter described in the *Basis for Qualified Opinion* paragraph, the financial statement is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of the Ontario Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions of election campaigns, completeness of contributions, other income and expenses is not susceptible of satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, my verification of these amounts was limited to the amounts recorded in the Candidate's election campaign records and I am not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to contributions, other income and expenses.

I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. My responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statement* section of the report. I am independent of Balbir Sohi in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to my audit of the financial statement in Ontario, and have fulfilled my other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my qualified opinion.

Emphasis of Matter - Basis of Accounting and Restriction of Use

The financial statement has been prepared to assist the Candidate to meet the financial reporting requirements of section 88.25 of the Ontario Municipal Elections Act, 1996. As a result, the financial statement may not be suitable for another purpose. My report is intended solely for the Candidate and the Clerk of the City of Brampton and should not be used by parties other than the Candidate or the Clerk of the City of Brampton. My opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Responsibility of Management and Those charged with Governance for the Financial Statement

The Candidate is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statement in accordance with the Ontario Municipal Elections Act, 1996, and for such internal control as the Candidate determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the financial statement that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

The Candidate is responsible for overseeing the financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibility for the Audit of the Financial Statement


My objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statement as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes my opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with the Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this financial statement.

As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, I exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. I also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statement, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Candidate's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the Candidate.

I communicated with the Candidate regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that I identify during my audit.
