City Closure

National Day for Truth and Reconciliation; September 30, 2021

In June of this year, the government passed Bill C-5 to establish a new public holiday for federally regulated employers called the [National Day for Truth and Reconciliation](#).

This new holiday is action #80 from the 94 calls to action from the [Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada](#). The day seeks to honour First Nations, Inuit and Métis survivors, their families and communities, and to ensure that a public commemoration of their history and the legacy of residential schools remains a vital component of the reconciliation process.

Beginning this year, City facilities and offices will be closed to reflect and participate in the Truth and Reconciliation activities offered by the community.
