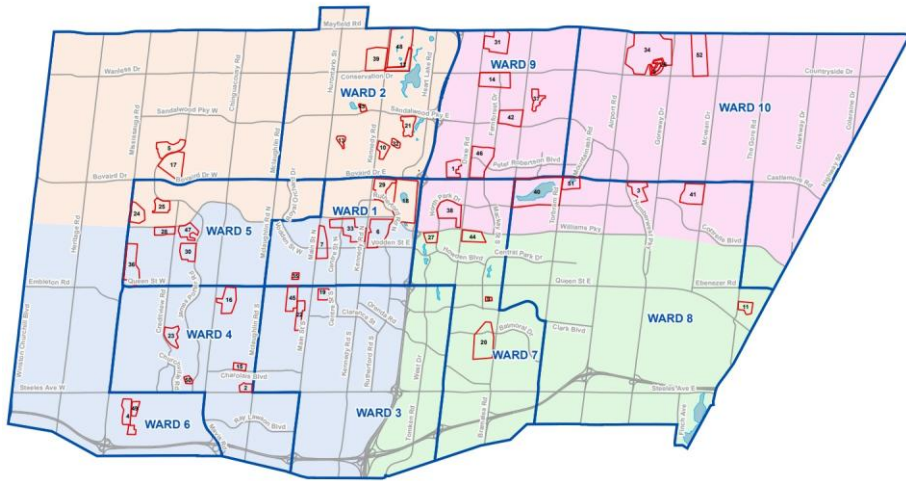

Affiliated Neighbourhood Association Program

Connecting residents and nurturing neighbourhoods to thrive.

The application period is open until **April 30, apply today!**



- 52 Neighbourhood Associations were affiliated in 2025.
- These groups completed 85 neighbourhood projects across the City with participation from over 7,000 residents!
- 88% of groups reported an increased sense of safety by participating in the program.

Crime Prevention Guide

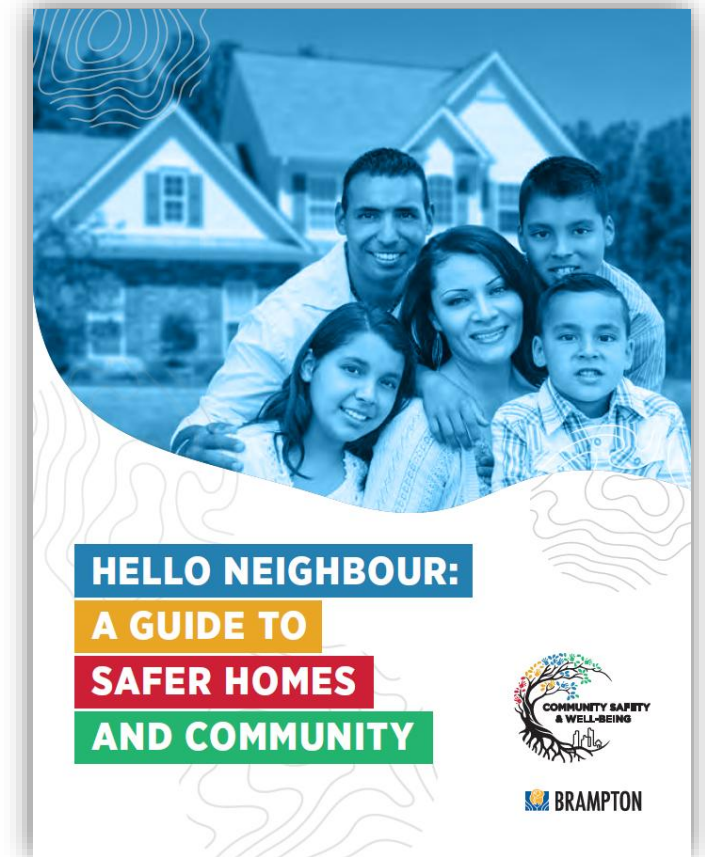
Results from community engagement:

Residents that describe knowing most or some of their neighbours also stated feeling safe in their neighbourhood.

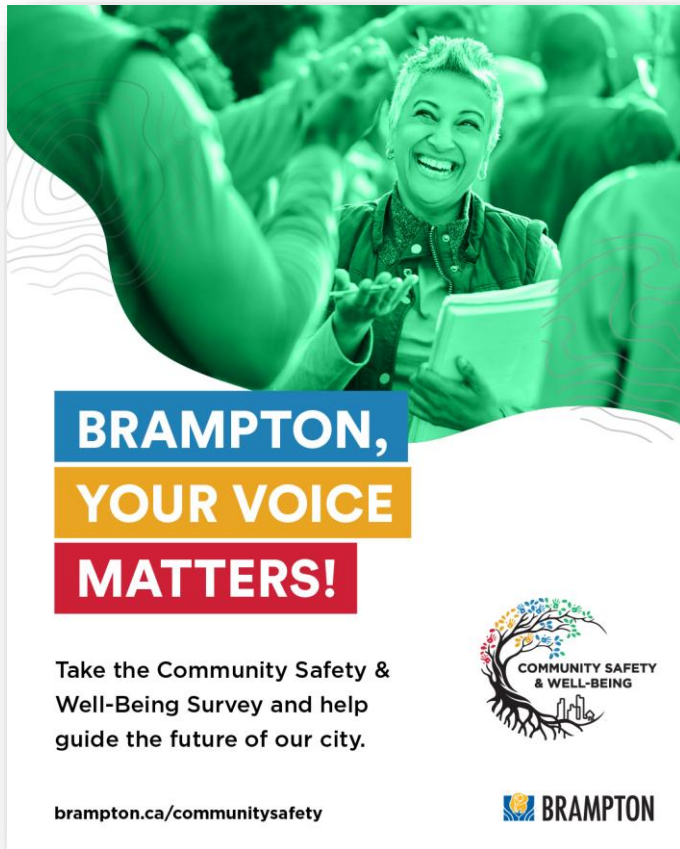
Similarly, a high number of residents reported a lower perception of safety when knowing none of their neighbours.
