



Draft Elements of Municipal Service Level Agreement

Primary Role

- Home Energy Retrofit Program
 - Act as a Information hub for residents
 - Coordinate energy audits and retrofits contractors
 - Liaison with the municipality for Local Improvement Charges (LIC) program
 - Develop partnerships with other non profit organizations undertaking home energy retrofits
 - Advise on municipal-led home/neighbourhood retrofit studies/programs
 - Advise on the development and implementation of the Peel Residential Efficiency Program
 - Liaison with municipal staff to seize upon strategic energy opportunities (ex. funding, partnerships)



Draft Elements of Municipal Service Level Agreement

Primary Role

- District Energy (DE) Program
 - Act as a Information hub for landowners and developers
 - Partner with developers and DE service providers to undertake Integrated Energy Plans for Urban and Town Centres
 - Coordinate with landowners with identified District Energy nodes
 - Participate in Business Case development for District Energy in Brampton, Mississauga, Caledon
 - Advise on municipal-led district energy studies/programs
 - Secure District Energy funding and investment
 - Liaison with municipal staff to seize upon strategic district energy opportunities (ex. funding, partnerships, advocacy)



Draft Elements of Municipal Service Level Agreement

Secondary Role

- Industrial, Commercial and Institutional (ICI) Efficiency
 - Act as a information hub for ICI sector
 - Investigate opportunities for Local Improvement Charges (LIC) for employment areas
 - Build a network of cross-sector partners and energy managers
 - Participate in municipal-led ICI energy efficiency studies/programs
 - Secure ICI energy efficiency funding and investment
 - Liaison with municipal staff to seize upon strategic opportunities
