
SUSAN FENNELL Sportsplex youth hub

An existing 2,850 sq. ft. general purpose area and craft room at the centre has been selected as one of two locations in the City that will be

converted into a youth-centric space.


The Youth Hub will act as a one-stop shop for services and activities for youth ages 14 to 29, offering access to:

Between October 26 and November 23, 2020, the City of Brampton held a series of community consultation sessions with Brampton's youth, youth serving organizations and City staff.

Feedback gathered through the consultation process has been used to inform the development of conceptual designs for these spaces.

Participants envisioned the Community Youth Hubs as:

- Spaces that serve as catalysts for personal development, growth and creative exploration;
- Spaces that recognize the diverse background and cultural interests of Brampton's residents; and,
- A place where youth feel they have the capacity to help shape a space that fits their interests and needs.
