Torbram Road Improvements From Queen Street East to Bovaird Drive Class Environmental Assessment Study

The Study

The City of Brampton is carrying out Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study to identify transportation improvements Torbram Road from Queen Street East to Bovaird Drive (see map). In order to best address operational deficiencies and need for additional north-south capacity in the area, a number of alternatives are being examined as part of the study. Alternatives include the potential widening of Torbram to six lanes, intersection improvements, active transportation, transit improvements and the impact of such improvements on the social. cultural and natural environments.

The Process

The study is being carried out in accordance with the planning and design process for Schedule 'C' projects as outlined in the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* (October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011, 2015), which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.
