
Improvements to Sandalwood Parkway From McLaughlin Road to Heart Lake Road Class Environmental Assessment Study

The Study

The City of Brampton is carrying out a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study to identify transportation improvements to Sandalwood Parkway from McLaughlin Road to Heart Lake Road (see map). In order to best address operational deficiencies and the need for additional east-west capacity in the area as a result of future growth, various alternative solutions were identified.

The Process

The EA study is being conducted in keeping with the Ontario *Environmental Assessment Act*, and will follow the Municipal Class EA (Schedule C) process. Input from the public and agencies is an important part of the EA study. The first PIC was held on Nov. 02, 2017 to review the need and justification for improvements to Sandalwood Parkway, the problems and opportunities, existing conditions and alternative solutions. Thereafter, the preferred alternative solution was determined taking into consideration the problems being addressed, environmental effects, and comments received from regulatory agencies and the Public. The preferred alternative solution included improvements of active transportation, transit, traffic demand management and road network including intersection improvements and widening from 4 to 6 lanes.



A second PIC has been arranged to review the preliminary preferred design and to receive public comments. Following the second PIC, the preliminary preferred design will be reviewed and confirmed taking into consideration the comments received.
