

Norval Quarry Rezoning Application Stakeholder Update #6

The City of Brampton has received copy of the Ministry of Natural Resources' (MNR) letter declaring Brampton Brick's Aggregate Resources Act (ARA) licence application complete (see attachment). The letter sets out the next steps for notification and public consultation of the licence application based on the requirements of the Aggregate Resources of Ontario Provincial Standards, Section 4.0.

By the end of September, we expect to receive copies of the materials submitted to MNR in support of the licence application. We will make these materials available to the public at the Planning Counter on the 3rd floor of City Hall. Again, we will provide another stakeholder update once this, or any other information that becomes available.
