Dear Stakeholders,

We are writing to advise you that the Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR) has posted Brampton Brick's Norval Quarry licence application on the Environmental Bill of Rights (EBR) Registry, *reference number 011-1911*. Persons interested in providing their comments related to Brampton Brick's licence application on the Registry must do so prior to **January 24, 2011**. Please note, comments posted on the EBR Registry and objections submitted as part of the Aggregate Resources Act (ARA) 45-day public notification period are different processes. Comments on the Registry are directed to MNR only, as Brampton Brick is not involved in this process. During the ARA 45-day public notification period, objections must be made to both Brampton Brick and the MNR, to comply with the ARA process requirements. In accordance with a resolution passed at the December 15, 2010 meeting of Brampton City Council, City staff has requested that the MNR expedite a review of Brampton Brick's public notification process regarding their Norval Quarry license application, under the ARA.
