



The City of Brampton is launching a study to develop an Active Transportation Master Plan. This study will identify existing opportunities, consider and evaluate solutions, and recommend an active transportation network and supporting policies for pedestrian and bicycle facilities.

Our goal is to make walking, cycling and other non-motorized modes a safe, practical, and attractive option for getting around Brampton and beyond. A key outcome of the study will be a list of active transportation projects that the City can implement through road capital projects or as separate initiatives through to the year 2041.

This study builds on the Transportation Master Plan Update (2015), and supports the City's Strategic Plan priority to "Move and Connect" by delivering well-planned infrastructure to shape a liveable city.
