About Our Program

Thank you for considering one of our cats for your farm.

We are looking for cat lovers who have a barn or other secure outdoor structure and are interested in adopting cats not suitable for life inside of a house. The cats available for the barn program are considered to be poor house adoption candidates generally due to their previous habitat on the streets or the lack of ability to socialize with people and other cats.

Prior to adoption, all the cats will be spayed/neutered, dewormed and vaccinated for FVRCP and rabies. There is no fee for adopting our barn cats but a donation is appreciated to cover the cost of medical treatment.

If at any time after adoption you find you are unable to continue to care for the cat, please contact Animal Services to make arrangements for its return.
