Estimate the age of the kittens





Eves closed or barely open





2-4 weeks old

Eves open and alert; becoming mobile





4-6 weeks old

Very mobile and often talkative: can eat food





6-8 weeks old

Verv active and playful; around 1-2 pounds





8+ weeks old

Very active and playful; 2 pounds or more



STOP! Can you see the mom cat or a nest?





Don't kit-nap!

A kitten's best chance of survival is with mom. Leave the kittens where thev are and call us for more information.

Are you sure?

Mom may be off hunting or not want to come around if people are present. Watch for her to come back for a few hours.

Pro tip: Leave a ring of flour around the kittens. Check in a few hours if you see mom's foot prints in the flour! Contact us for more information on having the kittens admitted to the shelter for medical treatment, spay/ neuter, and adoption. We can also help determine if mom is a candidate for adoption or spay and return to field.
