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<ul> <li>Build your Kit: Pet supplies (food, collar, leash, pet carrier) and food for special dietary needs</li> <li>Activities: Plan for someone to take care of your pets if you are at work when an emergency occurs</li> <li>Events: Earth Day</li> </ul>	Build your Kit: Three day supply of water (4 litres per person per day) plus for pet Activities: Talk with neighbours to find out who has useful skills or training for an emergency Events: CeleBrampton, Brampton Farmers' Market	<b>Build your Kit:</b> Rain gear, hats, scarves, rope <b>Activities:</b> Make an emergency kit for your car <b>Events:</b> School begins, Brampton Farmers' Market	Build your Kit: Heavy gloves, safety goggles, disposable dust mask, playing cards, games, books, magazines Activities: Check to see if stored items have expired and need to be replaced Events: New Year's Eve Celebration

<b>Build your Kit:</b> Cash in small bills, portable cranked or battery operated AM/FM radio, extra batteries <b>Activities:</b> Make photocopies of all important documents and prescriptions <b>Events:</b> National Volunteer Week	<b>Build your Kit:</b> Scissors, utility knife, duct tape, whistle, extra clothing and shoes <b>Activities:</b> Identify vulnerable neighbours who might need help in an emergency <b>Events:</b> Canada Day, Brampton Farmers' Market	<b>Events:</b> Brampton Farmers' Market end, Fire Prevention Week	<b>Build your Kit:</b> Sleeping bag or blanket for each person, manual can opener, flashlight and batteries <b>Activities:</b> Change the batteries and test your smoke and CO alarm <b>Events:</b> New Year's Levee
MAY <b>Build your Kit:</b> Medications (pain relievers etc.), special	AUGUST	NOVEMBER	FEBRUARY <b>Build your Kit:</b> Toilet paper and other personal hygiene
needs items (infant formula etc.), hand sanitizer <b>Activities:</b> Encourage family members and friends to prepare for emergencies <b>Events:</b> Emergency Preparedness Week, Business Continuity Awareness Week, National Public Works Week	Activities: Meet with neighbours to inventory expensive equipment that could be shared in the event of an emergency (chain saws, snow blowers, etc) Events: Brampton Farmers' Market	eating and drinking utensils Activities: Make an emergency kit for your pets Events: Remembrance Day Parade & Service, Tree Lighting, Santa Claus Parade	items, non-perishable food, First Aid Kit <b>Activities:</b> Make a family emergency plan (home escape plan, communications plan, important phone numbers) <b>Events:</b> Black History Month
