Stakeholder Update #9

Dear Stakeholders,

Brampton Brick has advised the City that the 45-day Notification and Consultation process, as per the Aggregate Resource Act (ARA), will begin on **Thursday, November 4, 2010**. Notification includes:

- Advertisement in a local newspaper;
- Signage on the property;
- Application package to municipalities and public agencies;
- Written notice by registered mail to landowners within 120m;
- ARA Form 1-Notice of Licence Application; and
- ARA Form 2 Notice of Public Information Session

Brampton Brick has also advised that the public open house they are required to host, as per the ARA, will be held on **Tuesday, November 30, 2010** from 4 to 8 pm at Brampton Brick Limited, 255 Wanless Drive.

If any person wishes to object to the licence application, then an objection must be filed in writing with reasons for objecting and the written objection must be sent to BOTH Brampton Brick and to the Ministry of Natural Resources, to be received no later than the end of the business day on **Monday**, **December 20, 2010**. When the 45-day public consultation period ends, then Brampton Brick is required to resolve, with the objector, the objections that are received.
